# SHORT TERM SESSIONS

## ALPACA AND ANIMAL THERAPY (2 HOURS) FROM £120

Meet, feed and help with the care of the animals on the farm. Work with hens, ducks, sheep, alpacas and dogs.

## ALPACA TREK & ANIMAL THERAPY (3 HOURS) FROM £150

Meet, feed and help on the farm with the care of the animals and get to know the alpacas in more detail. We will feed, halter and take the alpacas for a walk through the fields. Small groups, aged 8+.

## WOODLAND WELLBEING/OUTDOOR LEARNING (2 HOURS) FROM £120

Spend time in the woods lighting fires, building shelters, using tools, nature crafts and cooking on the campfire. Activities vary dependent on group size, age and ability.

## ANIMAL & WOODLAND (4 HOURS) FROM £175

Spend two hours with the animals and a short alpaca trek, bring a picnic lunch or we can cook on the campfire. Spend the afternoon in the woods carrying out activities to suit the needs of the group.

## ONE TO ONE SESSIONS (1 HOUR) FROM £30 PP

We offer 121 sessions to meet specific objectives set

## WORKSHOPS & COURSES

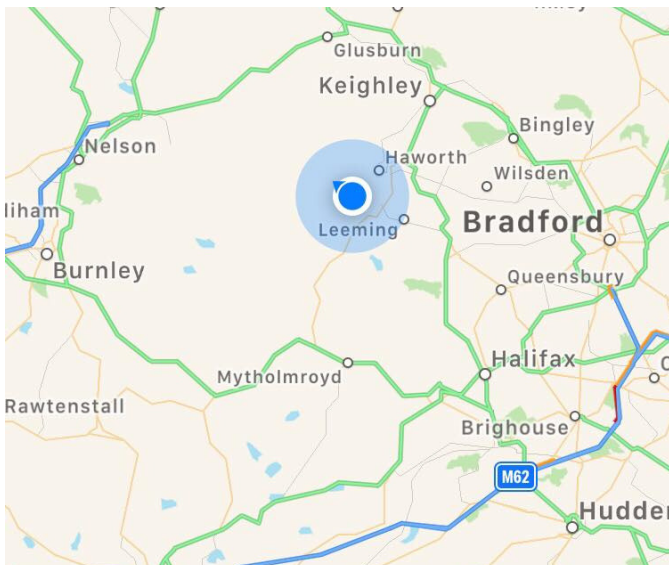

We have a bespoke volunteer programme for long term placement as a step up into employment. Volunteers are involved in all areas of the Care Farm and can work towards AQA units and gains various skills to help their personal development. We have availability three days per week for volunteers to work at the farm as part of their transition process. Fees are from £50 per day/volunteer.

We run sessions for adults and children with learning disabilities, ASD, SEN and mental health problems on Mondays and Thursdays on a short and long term basis.
